EAA Chapter 1268 BOARD MINUTES March 13, 2012

The meeting was called to order at 6:12 p.m. Present were President Travis Morton, Treasurer Bill Wheadon, board members Paul Siebert, Walt Lewis and Darrel Jones, Dinner Coordinator Roy Myers, and guest EAA Chapter 167 President Richard Craig, also a Chapter 1268 member.

Richard briefed the officers about the EAA B-17 visit to Napa scheduled for May 3 through 7 and invited Chapter 1268 to participate with Vacaville Chapter 1230 also invited. The Board approved Chapter 1268's participation pending approval by the membership. The Napa chapter will fly Young Eagles during the B-17 visit on Saturday May 5. Net proceeds will be divided evenly between the three chapters.
