YOUNG EAGLES, SEPT. 29: EAA's Ken

Mercer and many others are in process of organizing their Gnoss day for Young Eagles. Ken will probably speak briefly at our September 8 breakfast to brief you on this. Please consider, if you're not already involved with Young Eagles, making yourself and your aircraft available for a flight or two on this date. Here are some comments from Ken recently about this great program:

Our Young Eagles day at Gnoss is scheduled for Saturday, September 29 this year and we'd love to have GFCA join us not only to fly some kids that morning, but also just to hang around and talk to the parents. There's been a lot of interesting discussion lately about the "payback" from 18 years of Young Eagles flights, and even though fully 22% of all pilots certificated in the past ten years had been Young Eagles the bigger payback seems to be in the form of community education and exposure to general aviation.

EAA has also initiated a new program to introduce adults to general aviation in much the same way Young Eagles started-with an introductory flight experience. I think we've all done that for years, on our own, but this program will provide additional insurance to pilots who participate and ultimately will be expanded to include some of the same educational opportunities (such as the Sporty's online ground school which is available free of charge to Young Eagles) and scholarships that are currently available to Young Eagles. I can provide a free 6 month trial EAA membership to any pilot who might like to give such flights, or Young Eagles flights.

Please consider flying for this event this year, or coming out to talk with the kids and parents. It's a great event.
