The meeting was called to order by President Morton at 6:00 p.m.

Reports:

Travis Morton: Property tax for the clubhouse is due. The Chapter participated in the Sonoma Skypark Family Fun Day open house October 13.

Walt Lewis: Reported that he is stepping down as the Air Explorer Post 1268 advisor and that Robin Tatman has volunteered as the new Post advisor.

Jeanette Woods reported on planning for the annual Sonoma Skypark Family Fun Day this October 13 and asked for volunteers to help. She reported on the many donations by members and the local community and described the activities planned for the day. Set up will start Friday evening at 4 pm. Nominations were suggested for Chapter officers for 2013. Don Booker has agreed to run for President. Jeanette Woods, Marsi Fahraji, Bill Wheadon, Paul Siebert and Darrel Jones have all agreed to continue in their respective positions for 2013. Walt Lewis and Gardner Bride declined to run for an additional term. Robin Tatman volunteered to serve on the Board of Directors. Nominations will be requested from the membership during the regular meeting.

The Board meeting was adjourned at 6:55.

EAA CHAPTER 1268 MINUTES November 13, 2012

EAA Chapter 1268, Board of Directors Meeting

President Morton called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Present: President Travis Morton, Vice-President Jeanette Woods, Secretary Marsi Fahraji, Board members Paul Siebert, Darrel Jones and Walt Lewis, Young Eagles liaison BK White, Treasurer and Membership Chair Bill Wheadon. Also present was Rich Cooper and Robin Tatman.

President Morton reported that the Sonoma County property tax has been paid on the clubhouse. He also reported that the flight school is featured in an upcoming issue of Sonoma Magazine.

Darrel Jones reported that he sent the deposit for the 2013 Air Academy in to reserve two slots in the Basic and four slots in the Advanced Air Academies. The total deposit was \$1,200.00 for the six slots. Because the Chapter can't depend on the national EAA offering any scholarships, we will only be able to commit to full sponsorship for two participants. The other slots will be offered to any other members wishing to fully fund their own participant before releasing the slots to other chapters.

Darrel also reported that an invitation has been extended to the Sonoma Skypark neighbors to meet at the airport for hamburgers on December 1 at 2 p.m. to let them know what we do at the airport.

Walt Lewis reported that he was working on the transfer of information to Robin Tatman

who will be the new Air Explorer Post 1268 advisor.

The Board thanked Walt for starting the Air Explorer Post and for making it a success over the years. They also thanked Walt and Gardner for their service to the Chapter as Board members.

Paul led the Board in thanking Travis for his service as President of the Chapter for the past two years and acknowledged his many contributions to the Chapter.

Jeanette Woods reported on planning for the annual Sonoma Skypark and EAA Chapter 1268 Christmas party for December 7 in Ron Price's hangar.

BK White: the November 11 Young Eagles flew 31 young people with 6 pilots. He also reported that a memorial fly-over was conducted the same morning over the Veterans' memorial services held at the Sonoma Veterans cemetery at 11 a.m.

Bill Wheadon reported that there are already 21 renewals for 2013 and the bank balance is \$3,529.01.

Paul Siebert suggested ways to recruit more young people into the Chapter and into flying. He encouraged Travis to offer EAA trail subscriptions to his students at the flight school. EAA offers a free six-month subscription to the magazine to all Eagle flight participants.

Rich Cooper suggested that the Chapter organize a formation flying clinic to enhance safety during events such as the memorial fly-over the preceding Sunday.

Robin Tatman suggested having Eagle Flight sign-ups at the Young Eagles days.

There were no additional nominations for officers. The membership will be asked to vote for a "white ticket" slate of un-opposed candidates at the general meeting with officers installed at the December Christmas party.

Safer Skies Through Education

Correction: Paper Pilot Certificates Notice Number: NOTC4466

Oops! We made a mistake in a recent Notice. Here is the revised Notice.

If you have already replaced your paper pilot certificate, then this message is not for you. On the other hand, if your pilot certificate is still printed on paper, please read carefully.

The FAA is under a mandate to replace all paper certificates with plastic certificates. In fact, paper **pilot** certificates have already expired!

If you are a mechanic, on the other hand, and do not replace your paper certificate on or before March 31, 2013, you will no longer be able to exercise your privileges!

All certificated Airmen, including mechanics, repairmen, pilots, etc., are required to replace their paper copy with a plastic copy, or they will no longer be able to exercise the privileges of that certificate.

The best way to get a new replacement certificate is to follow the instructions at <u>http://www.faa.gov/licenses_certificates/a</u> irmen_certification/certificate_replacement/.

The replacement cost is \$2.00, unless you still have your Social Security Number on your certificate and you ask to have it removed. Avoid the Rush! Apply today!
