A field trip to Travis Air force Base for a tour of a KC-10 was a success on many levels. The field trip included an in depth tour of the carrier, vis-à-vis interfacing (Q&A) with pilots, and real-time information on the best avenues for pursuing aviation in a military arena. Many thanks to the parents & Robin who teamed up to drive: Tina, Margo, Jill and Marsi.

For the October meeting, I gave a follow-up presentation about learning to fly that Marc Ashton started in August. He had explained how to choose a flight school, pick out an instructor, and then broke down the requirements and cost estimates for the rating. I focused on what you need to do after you finish your Private Rating and to get you to a point you can make money. On the educational side. I outlined a few accidents that have occurred in the airlines in the last several years and applied the new(er) Threat and Error Management model - a refinement on Cockpit Resource Management, to see how its application could have possibly prevented the accidents from taking place.

He has been diligently working behind the scenes to sell some of the parts and pieces that we have stored in the Air Explorer designated hangar in the club house.
