EAA 1268 MEMBERSHIP CHAIRMAN AND TREASURER REPORT APRIL 2015

Membership Report – Renewals for 2015 are progressing well with the number of blue badges (members who are current with their dues for you newbies) beginning to outnumber the white badges (members not current). So far we have 47 paid members for 2015. If you'd like to change your badge color from white to blue, give or send to me \$15. A membership form and Treasurer's address is on the last page of this newsletter.

Addendum for April – Since my last report we've had four renewals and one new member sign up.

Treasurer Report – As of February 28 our checking account balance stands at \$8790.40. Activity for the month included a check for \$455 that was sent to EAA National for our annual chapter renewal. A deposit of \$325 was made which consisted of \$240 members dues renewal and \$85 from the dinner excess proceeds.

Not included was a check for \$125.88 written to cover our website hosting.

Addendum for April – Our checking account balance at the end of March stands at \$9196.64. Activity in the account included the above mentioned dues renewal of \$75, an Air Academy donation of \$100, \$204 in dinner donations (countered by a check to Ron Price for \$195.88 to cover expenses for that delicious dinner) and two Air Academy applicants refundable deposits of \$200 totaling \$400.
