Hi from Air Explorers!

I am happy to report that Air Explorer Post 1268 has been officially re-chartered for 2016. We have 9 Explorer members plus two that are technically not old enough (13 minimum age for Exploring is 14) and are participating in the group as EAA members. Our newest member, Hugo McDougall comes all the way from Half Moon Bay to join us. Thanks again to Ron Price and the Airport for being our sponsor. Our first field trip of the year is on April 22-23, and we are going to tour and spend the night on the aircraft carrier USS Hornet in Alameda. Our own Rich Cooper will be joining us. He spent 3 years flying off of the USS Essex (very similar to the Hornet) while based in Guantanamo Bay. Rich told me "You can't spend over 3 years on a carrier without something happening to you." I believe him, and can't wait to hear him elaborate on that. So far, 9 kids are signed up to go (and a lot of adults!).
