**Treasurer Report** Activity in the checking account consisted of two deposits and one disbursement. A deposit relating to regular chapter business consisted of two renewals (\$30), an Air Explorer donation (\$50) and excess funds collected from the June dinner (\$96) for a total of \$176.

The second deposit were funds collected from Family Fun Day and being temporarily held in our account. These funds (\$1145) will be distributed to The Sonoma Mentoring Alliance and the Air Explorers, Post 1268.

We made a \$1108 payment to the EAA Air Academy to cover the balance due for our sponsorship of our four attendees.

Board of Directors meeting

The meeting was called to order at about 6:00 pm. Present were Robin Tatman, President, Don Booker, VP, Marsi Fahraji, Secretary, Bill Wheadon, Treasurer, Jeanette Woods, Paul Siebert and Darrel Jones, Board members, Ron Price, Skypark Manager, and Yayoi West, Family Fun Day coordinator.

Robin made the point that Family Fun Day planning needs to start much earlier, preferably in the fall. She suggested that Family Fun Day be held the weekend before Memorial Day to avoid conflicts with local graduation ceremonies.

Yayoi reported that \$1400 was collected. It will be divided between Sonoma Mentoring Alliance and the Aviation Explorer Post 1268.

Bill Wheadon will pay the balance of the tuition for the four Air Academy participants EAA Chapter 1268 and Sonoma Skypark are sponsoring to Air Academy camp at Oshkosh, WI this summer.

Young Eagles flew 21 kids with 4 pilots and 4 ground volunteers. The program needs more qualified pilots and more volunteers to help with registration and ground operations.

The officers' meeting was adjourned at 7:00-pm.

Dinner was provided by Ron Price with pasta and ice cream, Marsi Fahraji with fresh, homemade tomato sauce, Howard Hull bringing coffee, and Jeanette and Robin furnishing salad and garlic bread.

The membership meeting was called to order at 7:45.

Yayoi West gave her Family Fun Day report.

Jack Caldwell invited Chapter 1268 to hold their September meeting at his winery in Napa. Directions will be sent to the membership before the meeting.

Bill Wheadon reported that the Napa EAA Chapter 167 will donate to Chapter 1268's Air Academy scholarship fund.

Robin reported that the Aviation Explorer flyouts are cancelled but will be rescheduled for a later date. The Air Explorers sold fudge and cookies at Family Fun Day.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:15. The program was the May EAA Chapter video.
