At the last Napa EAA meeting he volunteered to serve as Chair for the upcoming Napa EAA Christmas party. Mark flies a Luscombe out of Napa and his son Marcus flies a Cessna 170, also based at Napa. Mark's father. John has an extensive aviation background – following WW2 he was involved in setting up an FBO at Napa - one of several that didn't survive the post war anticipated general aviation boom that didn't live up to expectations.

EAA CHAPTER 1268 MINUTES EAA 1268 Board of Directors Meeting September 11, 2018 The Board Meeting was called to order by Vice President Darrel Jones at 6:15 pm.

Present were: Vice President, Darrel Jones, Treasurer Bill Wheadon, Secretary Nelleke Cooper, Young Eagles Coordinator BK White. Absent: President Robin Tatman and Directors Jeanette Woods and Paul Siebert

First order of business: correction to the August 14 minutes: At the Young Eagles event 8/12 there was no "hot loading". The term was used by way of speech as to relay the loading as quickly as possible.

Minutes approved as corrected.

Young Eagle report for Sunday, September 9, 2018 by Bill Wheadon as BK White was absent due to a pet emergency at home. The only 2 pilots with airplanes available were Don Booker and Bill Wheadon. John Thomason and Ron Willits assisted on the ground. They flew 15 Young Eagles. More pilots need to be recruited to participate in our Young Eagles program.

Darrel reported that our Chapter received many Thank You letter from the Air Academy participants and will scan them to send on to the Air Academy.

Treasurer report: Deposit from excess dinner receipts \$147, \$50 donation for Air Academy and 2 dues renewals \$30 for total deposit of \$227. Checkbook balance \$10,323.77, savings account \$100.13

Darrel and Bill are working on finalizing filing with the Franchise Tax Board.

Flying club report. Airplane ownership - Darrel, Robin and Richard Craig purchased John Miles' Taylorcraft. It will be used for dual tailwheel instruction only. Membership includes paying a monthly Membership fee and rent the airplane at a reduced fee. Membership fees are to be determined.

BK white asked about the process of application for candidates for the Air Academy. There is a formal interview with parents or guardians and we have written explications for the application procedure.

New business: Darren Stevenson will give details on the Napa Airport Day on September 22 at the General Meeting.

Question regarding the updated member Roster, Bill Wheadon reported the roster was mailed out in a separate email.

Board Meeting adjourned at 6:50 pm.

General Meeting called to order by Vice President Darren Jones at 7:30 pm.

Darrel thanked Richard Craig, Sandra, George Thompson, Les Lucas and Carol Stevenson for a delicious dinner of toast with heirloom tomatoes and burrata cheese, shrimp, Rocky Mountain oysters, banana bread, chocolate cake and flourless brownies with raspberries and whipped cream.

Special guest Will Campbell took 100's of pictures at the Oshkosh Air Venture and shared some with us.

Other guests: Mark and Catherine Shackford, owner of a Luscombe 8D and a Cessna 170.

Officers gave their reports to the general Membership including the Treasurer's report.

BK White presented the Young Eagles report mentioning the shortage of pilots and line support. He made a suggestion to try to recruit pilots and helpers by placing a request in the Newsletter.

Walt Eastman announced his retirement from the Napa Railroad and has purchased property on an airpark in Texas with a 3000 ft. grass landing strip. Walt has been an active member of our Skypark community and has flown many Young Eagles having the advantage of being able to take 3 passengers in his Bonanza. Walt will be missed and we wish him all the best.

Bill Wheadon and Daren Stevenson invited our members to the Napa Airport Fly-In on September 22, with antique airplanes, Vintage Cars, Music, kids' stuff, hamburgers, hotdogs, etc. Time 10:00 to 3:30 pm.

16 Year old Nathan Wilson gave a professional presentation, accompanied by music, of his Air Academy and Air Venture experience. He thanked our Chapter and Darrel for all the support he received. He described the multiple workshops he attended, including making ribs and he got to go on many airplane rides with the highlight being a ride in a Bell 47 Helicopter.

Ernie Ganas gave us an update on the changes in the Class B airspace, bases on GPS coordinates. The map reads very different now as there are no more rings with the indicated airspeeds and transitions, but the transitions are in angles. Ernie flies a Bonanza and mentioned needing clearances for transitions.

After last month presentation by Steve Haller, Ernie was asked lots of questions regarding his flying out of Crissy Field from 1969 to 1971, while in the Army. Ernie flew many different airplanes there - Queen Airs, Twin Bonanzas, Beavers and helicopters. He was on duty during the 1970 Air Show. He described the unusual and many tricky approaches he made into the field and gave us details on the operations that took place at that time. The Crissy Field airstrip was closed in 1974 and the flying was moved to Hamilton Air Force base, which was closed in 1997.

General Meeting adjourned 9:00 pm.
