RAMBLINGS

Since I didn't quite get the officers reports, I will fill the rest of this page with a few observations and notes of possible interest.

First is an abbreviated report on AirVenture at Oshkosh.

I drove up to Cave Junction, Oregon, and flew back with my old Scouting buddy in his original 1958 straight tail Cessna 172. He had the engine rebuilt in 2016 and we flew back then to break it in. We flew again this year just to make sure it still runs.

Paul and I travelled from south-west Oregon to Montana to visit an old friend of his, and then went up to North Dakota to visit some of my friends. We then wound up in Brodhead at the Pietenpol fly-in where we had the chance to help hold down about a dozen Pietenpols tied down outside while a ferocious thunderstorm roared through. Brodhead caught just the southern tail of the storm that hit Oshkosh directly, dumping over five inches of rain on Oshkosh in just a couple hours. When we flew up Sunday, the airport was still closed to arrivals so we overnighted at Fond Du Lac.

We snuck in Monday posing as a general aviation aircraft because the vintage camping area was still under water and closed.

Sonoma Skypark had a good contingent at Oshkosh and Brodhead again this year. Ron's tent was EAA Chapter 1268 central, with Eric Presten there with Ben, Curtis and Curtis' girlfriend. Our own photographer Will Campbell was there, as was old Skypark friend Jim Roberts with his beautiful Swift. Jim and his Swift are featured in the latest issue of Vintage Aviation, the EAA Vintage Division magazine.

Ron has a complete list of the Skypark attendees, so I'll fill out the list next month. Ron also had his newly restored award-winning Luscomb 4 at Brodhead and Oshkosh.

Gretchen had set me up with a blog on the Chapter website, but I just couldn't find the time during the trip to write a post each day, or on any day for that matter. Mea culpa, again. I will try to write up something about the trip and maybe post it on the website and in the newsletter.

The other item is that Robin is still trying to get a flying club going at Sonoma Skypark so we can offer low cost flight instruction to our local youth, as well as affordable flying for local pilots who can't justify the expense of buying and maintaining their own airplane.

Robin, Richard and I bought John Miles's Taylorcraft but we still need to do some work to get it ready for flight instruction. Richard had been using John Thomason's Tri-Pacer for flight instruction but it suffered an engine failure so is out of action.

We were talking over lunch about finding a Cessna 150 or 152 to either buy or lease back so Richard can continue instructing. We would then use the Taylorcraft for tailwheel transition training. Please let us know if you have a line on a reasonably clean, mechanically sound airplane we could use to get the club going.
