Treasurer Report – There was one deposit made to our account in March for \$1195. This consisted of \$55 for dues renewal and a check from EAA National for \$1140 relating to a refund for our deposit to the Air Academy.

One check for \$282.66 was written to cover Sebastian Johnson's flight training. Our CD account earned \$9.38 in interest for the month. Total chapter funds in our three accounts total \$15,315.75. These are distributed as follows:
