The January meeting is this Tuesday, June 8. The Board of Directors will meet at 6:00 p.m. on Zoom.


The general membership meeting will start at 7 pm., also on Zoom.

AIRPORT HAPPENINGS The great news is that enough people have been vaccinated that the state is planning on lifting COVID-19 restrictions June 15. Finally! This means that we can get back to normal activities at Sonoma Skypark this month. Rafe will have his first movie and pizza night in over a year on Saturday, June 26. EAA Chapter 1268 will resume Young Eagles rides and in-person dinner meetings on July 11 and 13. We will start Saturday Hamburgers at Skypark as soon as we can line up a coordinator and crew.

We bid goodbye for now to Colin Traynor who is moving on to new adventures and opportunities in Los Angeles. Colin started as a part-time airport attendant five years ago, worked his way up to Assistant Manager and then Airport Manager. All this after coming to Sonoma Skypark for Young Eagles rides and eventually earning his private and instrument certificates.

The Board hired a new Airport Office Manager, Tina Masquelier. Tina originated in Napa Valley, earned a degree in electronic technology there, and went on to work in the wine and aviation technology industries. She also has her own historical home renovation business, cuvee' 59.

Tina has moved into the airport mobile home on the east end of the hangars and is painting and sprucing it up for what we hope is a long stay. She starts this week and the Board members will be working with her to familiarize her with airport operations. We owe Colin a big thank you for putting together a comprehensive airport operation manual to help with the transition.

Stop by the office and introduce yourself and get to know the newest member of the Sonoma Skypark team.

Richard and Dennis will continue working as Skypark Airport Attendants, with Mark Shackford's son, Marcus, filling out the week. Marcus is completing an aviation degree at Pacific Union College in Angwin. He has earned his certificates through multi-engine and is set to graduate this month with a bachelor's degree in aviation. He and Mark will be hosting a graduation celebration on Sunday June 13 from 3 to 6 pm in their hangar F-1.

Saturday hamburgers at Skypark needs a coordinator and crew! Since Ron retired and is spending more time travelling and just enjoying his retirement, Sonoma Skypark doesn't have someone to organize the Saturday barbecue. The coordinator's job is to simply contact the volunteers who will cook and serve each week and figure out what supplies are needed.

Ron had everything down to a science, so it won't be necessary to reinvent the wheel. We will need a cast of characters to volunteer to do the cooking, take the orders and serve, with three people each Saturday between 11 am and 2 pm on a rotating basis. We used the profits to pay for airfare for our EAA Air Academy participants each year and we also gave pilots a great excuse and location to fly out for that \$100 hamburger.

We would like to get the barbecue up and running by July 3.

EAA Chapter 1268 will start holding in-person dinner meetings again on July 13 if the State of California lifts the COVID-19 restrictions on June 15, as promised. We will also start flying Young Eagles rides on Sunday, July 11. If you

are a Sonoma Skypark pilot, we would love to have you join us at the meeting and join the Chapter. Dues is only \$15 per year and the company is terrific!

We have chosen two Ray Aviation Scholarship recipients this year, Sebastian Johnson and Philip Lachman. Both young men have been taking flight lessons with Richard Craig, with their parents paying for the lessons so far.

We have been awarded \$10,000 in Ray Aviation Scholarship funds and have the option to divide those funds between two students, with the Chapter making up the balance of the cost of their private pilot certificate.

Robin has offered \$3,000 from the Aviation Explorer treasury and the Board has committed additional scholarship funding from the Chapter treasury.

We will be appealing to our members to add to the scholarship account as we go along so we have funds available for future scholars. John Thomason contributed monthly to the fund and was instrumental in Chapter 1268 receiving the first Ray Aviation Scholarship grant for Nathan Wilson.

I just spent nearly \$100 for dinner for Catherine, my daughter Lolly and husband Zac, and myself, and that was just for take-out Thai food. I will eb contributing \$100 a month to the fund and challenge all of you to contribute whatever you can.

Call or email Bill and let him know you will be helping out. You can make your contribution an automatic monthly payment directly to our checking account. Best of all, Chapter 1268 is a non-profit and all contributions are tax deductible.

Airport maintenance and upgrades. Sonoma Skypark Board member Peter Gauthier has been working with a paving company on the airport runway, ramp and taxiway needs. The Board is talking about doing the necessary repairs and maintenance over a two-year period to spread out the cost and limit the disruption to regular airport activities. Peter is on his way back from the east coast, so we will have more information for you next month.

As Ron always said, "We run an asphalt farm."

We are progressing with the planning and permitting for the airport office remodel. The office building was built in 1967 and there haven't been any major repairs or upgrades other than a bathroom upgrade and some repairs to the deck. Ron and David Meeks started working with FIGO Construction Drawings over three years ago on plans to upgrade the restrooms to meet ADA requirements, and to repair the deteriorated parts of the building. We will let you know how the project is progressing as it develops.

Membership Report – Renewals for 2021 are running behind the historical average for this time of year with just a little over 42% of our current members having paid their \$15 that allows them to be in the "current" category and likewise sporting a blue badge. Since you haven't been able to be in the clubhouse recently to check your badge color (blue badge paid, white badge not paid) I'll accept that as a reason for the tardiness. Even though we haven't been meeting in person, club expenses go on with the primary expense being our annual dues to EAA national. This year's dues are \$535 with most of that sum going for chapter insurance. As a follow-up, I'll be sending out an email to those who are not paid up – please don't take it personally, even some of our officers and board members haven't paid yet!
