# EAA 1268 MEMBERSHIP CHAIRMAN AND TREASURER REPORT November 2021

For the month of October, we had two deposits in our checking account with no disbursements except for a \$5 withdrawal currency fee which is a puzzle to me since no withdrawals were made in October. We were assessed another

one of these fees for \$10 in January of last year which I was successful in reversing, but I had to go through the hassle of contacting customer service – hope this doesn't become a regular issue. I'll contact Redwood CU on Monday.

It was very fortuitous that we assumed operation of the Saturday BBQ – it has become an excellent fundraiser. Two deposits were made in October which included \$930 from the BBQ proceeds and also \$131 in dinner receipts from our October meeting.

Total chapter funds are \$23,617.42 distributed in the following accounts: Checking account - \$18321.35 Savings account - \$ 126.06 CD account - \$ 5296.07
