EAA 1268 MEMBERSHIP CHAIRMAN AND TREASURER REPORT JANUARY 2022

For the month of December 2021, we had one deposit of \$550 in our checking account which consisted of \$45 in dues renewal and two donations totaling \$505 to our scholarship fund.
