We've managed to keep our annual dues at \$15 only by having a large participation by our membership.

On another matter, I've had difficulty contacting some of our members to clarify an issue but have been unable to do so. Many people have gone to their cell phone as their primary and have either discontinued their land line or don't bother answering it.

# EAA CHAPTER 1268 MINUTES

Board of Directors Meeting January 11, 2022

The Board meeting was called to order at 6:12pm on January 11th, 2022 on Zoom

Present were President Robin Tatman (RT), VP Darrel Jones (DJ), Secretary Yayoi West (YW)

RT explained about Ray Aviation Scholarship's 2021 recipients. DJ and Roland Gangloff had a meeting with Marc Ashton of the Petaluma Training Center where the recipients are going to finish their private pilot training. DJ is scheduling tutoring for preparation for the written exam. Both 2021 recipients are very busy. Sebastian is a competition level gymnastic athlete, and needs to attend gymnastic training 4 days/week. Philips live in Albany and is involved in wrestling and Scouting. It is long distance for him to come to Skypark or Petaluma. We are trying to come up with a more structured program.

YW How have those two recipients were chosen?

DJ They were flying with Richard Craig at Skypark. And they were flying many hours,

25hours and 40hours each already with Richard.

YW Are those recipients going to Petaluma for ground school?

RT No, because of Covid, Marc can't do it and we need to tutor them. Marc is on the PAPA scholarship committee and our Ray Scholarship recipients also received \$3500 each from PAPA.

RT and DJ have been talking about, and I am also interested in, increasing the Chapter membership. There is a Webinar talk about how to increase members. (RT, DJ, YW will be taking it).

Regarding center piece decorations for the Skypark Christmas Party, if we can find old style wood airplanes, we can make an activity for Young Eagles to paint them for decorations for the next Christmas party. 60 airplanes can be purchased for \$80, which is a good deal. RT will place an order.

(Going back talking about Ray Scholarship) YW Please explain about the Scholarship. RT The scholarship goes to the chapter to train youth private pilot students. If we are successful one year, it makes easier to be approved for a scholarship by EAA for the following year.

DJ Ray Scholarship is one-\$10,000 award for a single student, or two-\$5000 awards for two students. We chose two for 2021 after successful the Chapter's 2020 recipient, Nathan Wilson, completed his private pilot check ride.

RT We also make sure the Ray Scholarship recipients to apply for the PAPA scholarship. Then they will receive a total of \$8500 and Chapter contribute \$5,000 to each candidate.

DJ The recipients have to finish flight test by November 2022. They can study and fly every

Sunday until summer, then can increase their training during summer vacation.

DJ has already applied for two \$5000 2022 Ray Scholarships. Chapter 1268 will contribute up to \$5,000 to each scholarship recipient.

RT What will be the best way to receive donation? I heard it works better if we ask individually.

YW It would be good to know how much we need. Then members have some idea and a goal to donate. How about online auction? How much do we need?

DJ We don't need any additional funds for the 2021 Scholarships, but we need \$10,000 toward the 2022 Ray Scholarship.

RT Family Fun Day would be helpful, too.

The Board meeting was adjourned at 6:50 pm.

General meeting called to order at 7 pm

The program for the evening was a presentation by Marc Ashton, from the Petaluma Pilot Training Center, on the increasingly rigorous training and testing required for the private pilot, as well as all other, pilot ratings.
