VICE-PRESIDENT'S REPORT

The new year has lots happening.

First, we are continuing to grant scholarships to local young people to attend the EAA Air Academy in Oshkosh in the summer, and to support them with flight training for their private pilot certificate. So far, we have one Air Academy participant and three other student pilots in flight training.

We have ambitious plans for the clubhouse as well. First priority is to renovate the restrooms, and then to give our kitchen a good facelift. Both those projects were completed years ago with EAA Chapter members pitching in funds and their labor.

We're initially asking for donations to raise \$30,000 to get the restroom done by early summer. The Chapter will be offering matching funds of \$5,000 to get the fundraising drive started, with the Air Explorers adding to that. We are also planning a Chapter build project, with a Pietenpol Aircamper as the proposed first project. The goal is to get young people

involved in actually building an airplane, with Chapter members mentoring them along the way.

We are cleaning up the restroom hangar building to use for building the project.

So get ready for a great year in 2023 for Chapter 1268!

EAA CHAPTER 1268 MINUTES

November 9, 2022

The Board meeting was called to order at 6:06 pm on November 8th, 2022 at the Harry F. West Jr. Memorial Clubhouse

Present were Donald Booker (DB), Darrel Jones (DJ), Bill Wheadon (BW), Yayoi West (YW) Nelleke Cooper (NC), Robin Tatman by zoom (RT), Roland Gangloff (RG)

DJ We have received an application from Finley Skaggs to attend the EAA Air Academy in 2023.

BW Made a motion to approve Chapter 1268 sponsoring Finley Skaggs to AirVenture next year. The motion was approved by the Board.

DJ Christmas party is Saturday Dec 3rd this year. The location will be the First Congregational Church again this year. Set up is from noon to 3pm on the same day.

YW Yayoi volunteered to be the chairperson for a Chapter Build an Airplane project. She researched on the EAA website and other sites about home-built airplanes. The Pietenpol Air Camper is one of three featured airplanes for building. Aircraft Spruce sell its plans and parts, at a total cost of less than \$7000 without tax or shipping.

DJ said he has a set of the plans for the Pietenpol.

YW said she will work after the holidays to find out which members are interested in participating in the project.

RT said Darrel and she briefly talked about clubhouse upgrade needs to be done. It would be nice to have bathroom and kitchen improvements done by early summer.

DJ said he is planning on scheduling some Saturday work parties to clean and organize the workshop/restroom building after the holidays.

DJ stated that the Chapter will need to do a fundraising drive. It will cost \$25K to \$30K for materials to renovate the restrooms. We can use member volunteers with construction experience to do the construction.

RG suggested that a good way to kick off fundraising for the renovation and for Pietenpol building project is to offer matching Chapter funding of \$5000 for donations.

DJ will draft a lease agreement with Sonoma Skypark to clarify the Chapter's relationship with the airport and ownership of the clubhouse building.

RT said there are still funds in the Air Explore account that can be used for matching fund raising. She will transfer those funds to the Chapter.

DJ reported he have applied for matching fund \$5,000 Ray scholar-ships for 2023 for two people.

RG volunteered as membership chairman to solicit new members for the Chapter.

DJ DB has agreed to organize the Saturday barbecue for November with Marilyn Seibert taking over after November. Don will work with Marilyn on the transition. The sign-up sheet for volunteers is on-line. DJ will email the kink to the members again and include it in the newsletter.

The officers agreed to serve again in 2023. DB said he would continue until a new president volunteers.

The Board meeting was adjourned at 6:56 pm.

Dinner was provided by Bill Wheadon and consisted of Asian-Italian fusion with rice, meat balls, scalloped potatoes, salad, chocolate cake and ice cream.

DB called a short membership meeting after dinner for the election of officers for 2023. The present officers and Board members agreed to continue serving in 2023. Don asked for a volunteer for president. Having no volunteers, Don agreed to continue in that office until a new president can be found. Gretchen McDougall and Darrel Jones agreed to be the Young Eagles liaisons for 2023.

The Chapter still needs dinner and speaker coordinators.

The presentation was by Ivy Morrison, who talked about her experiences as one of Chapter 1268's 2022 Air Academy participants. Will Campbell had a slide show during dinner of photos of the Reno air races.

NASA'S WRITING CHALLENGE FOR K-12 STUDENTS: POWER TO EXPLORE

Sonoma Valley students are invited to submit written descriptions of their space explorations dreams. The challenge is to research Radioisotope Power Systems (RPS) and dream up a new RPS powered space mission. If this sounds like rocket science, well, it is!

Students, parents, and teachers are invited to attend an informational meeting at Sonoma Valley Library Community Room, 755 W. Napa Street, on Saturday, December 17, at 1 p.m. to watch short videos, ask questions, and obtain handouts.

NASA Solar System Ambassador and Sonoma resident Yayoi West can guide students through the process. She is a licensed pilot, has traveled the world including both the North Pole and South Pole, and has been part of Richard Branson's space exploration efforts centered in New Mexico.

The deadline to submit is January 17, 2023. Maximum 200-word entries will be judged in three grade level categories: K-4, 5-8, and 9-12. The contest will have 45 semi-finalists, who will win prize packs, 9 finalists, who will win a chance to participate in a video conference with NASA experts, and 3 winners, who will be awarded a two-day trip for two to NASA's Glenn Research Center in Cleveland, Ohio.
