EAA 1268 MEMBERSHIP CHAIRMAN AND TREASURER REPORT OCTOBER 2023

One bank deposit was made in August totaling \$1,700.00. Included in the deposit was \$1,025 in donations for the Richard Cooper Memorial Fund, \$30 in dues renewal, \$145 in receipts from our September dinner, and \$500 from our Saturday BBQ fund raiser. We also received a check from EAA National in the amount of \$1650 as a final reimbursement for the flight training one of our Ray Scholars received at Mike Smith Aviation. This brings our total deposits for the month to \$3350.

Our CD account earned \$15.27 in interest and our savings account brought in another \$2.89.

Expenses totaling \$2850 were for a check to Mike Smith Aviation (\$1650) for the flight training of one of our Ray Scholars. Another check in the amount of \$1200 to EAA was a tuition deposit for candidates attending the 2024 Air Academy.

Total chapter funds are \$39,996.55 distributed in the following accounts:

Savings account - \$ 7,651.54 CD account - \$ 5,408.75

CD account - \$ 5,408.75

Total account funds \$39,996.55

Our bank did make a mistake on our monthly account by charging our account \$5,000 for a check that was written on another account with a similar account number – I'll remedy this tomorrow when I call the bank. The above numbers have taken this error into account.

EAA CHAPTER 1268 MINUTES

September 12, 2023

Board of Directors Meeting

Board meeting called to order at 6 pm

Present were new President Robin Tatman, Vice President Darrel Jones, Treasurer Bill Wheadon, incoming Treasurer Ray Gallarate and Board members Roland Gangloff and Nelleke Cooper.

Darrel asked that the Board approve Hayden Holbrook as one of the Chapter 1268 2024 Ray scholars. He had sent Hayden's application and school transcripts to the officers before the meeting. The Board voted to approve Hayden's scholarship for 2024.

Bill reported that Redwood Credit Union will be converting all accounts and that the chapter will need to update the controlling individuals and account signers at the end of the year.

Yayoi West had informed the Board that she would be stepping down as secretary as of

October. The Board discussed the need for a new Secretary. Darrel will perform the duties until a volunteer is found as the new Secretary.

Robin brought up the need for a Standard Operating Procedures manual for the Chapter to make the transition of officers go smoothly. The officers will write up a description of each of their duties and Darrel will compile them into a SOP manual before the new year.

Bill reported that he will get the final statement of charges for Kate Llodra and will pay Mike Smith the balance of the funds available in her Ray scholarship account. Kate will be responsible for any costs above those covered by the scholarship.

Robin reported that Luis has his checkride scheduled for the first week of October. (He took and passed his checkride October 3).

The board discussed a possible second candidate for the Chapter's 2024 Ray scholarship. Young Eagles candidates will be considered at future meetings.

Darrel reported that He will apply for our 2024 matching funds Ray scholarships as soon as the application period opens November 1. He will also submit Hayden's application as soon as those applications open January 1, 2024.

Darrel estimated that the roof repair on the shop hangar could run \$2,500. The Board approved spending up to that amount. The roof leaks badly now and risks ruining the Pietenpol building project and the tools donated to the Chapter during the winter rains.

Robin suggested asking Sonoma Skypark for a donation of some of the Jack Strehl funds given by the Chapter to Ron Price to go toward renovating the restrooms. The clubhouse building fund has collected \$10,930, of which \$3,793 has been spent on the kitchen upgrades, leaving a balance of \$7,136. The budget for the restroom renovation is \$30,000, leaving the

Chapter \$22,864 short of the funds needed. (hint, hint)

Robin suggested asking George Bachich to put a request into the Sonoma Skypark newsletter asking for donations to the clubhouse building fund.

Darrel reported that President Emeritus Don Booker is doing well and recovering nicely. Several of the other Chapter members have been having health issues as well. Darrel will try to have more information in the upcoming month.

Darrel reported that he has made the reservations for EAA Air Academy for 2024, with two Basic camp in each session, for a total of four Basic slots for campers 14 to 15 years old, and one Advanced reservation in each session, for a total of two Advanced slots for campers ages 16 through 18. Because of the popularity of the Advanced camps, each Chapter is limited to one slot per session in the Advanced camp.

Board Meeting adjourned at 7 pm

General meeting called to order at 7:30 pm

The officers gave a brief report on the business discussed during the Board meeting.

General Meeting adjourned at 7:45 pm

Because of a change in plans, dinner was provided by Darrel Jones and consisted of roast chicken, scalloped potatoes, tossed green salad and apple and pumpkin pie. Since the attendance was rather light, there were lots of leftovers to send home with members.

The program for the evening was presentations by our 2023 Air Academy participants, Ivy and Iris Morrison, Finley Skaggs and James Kurniawan, and Ray scholars Thomas Rickard, Kate Llodra, Sebastian Johnson and Luis Membria. They talked about the highlights of their experiences at camp and earning their private pilot licenses, and thanked Chapter 1268 members for their support, both financially and emotionally. The Ray scholars were presented with their polo shirts and pins for completing their training.
