Jeanne and her deceased husband Jim had been part of Sonoma SkyPark, Inc. since its beginning in 1986. They were both accomplished pilots and were among the first of the owners to build a hangar here in 1987 (B-1). \_Jeanne was always willing to help with projects at SkyPark and served as President, Treasurer, CFO and Bookkeeper for our Board of Directors. Another SkyPark aviation personality went West on January 31, when "Tat" Tatman passed away. Tat had a long career in aviation starting in the days of lighted airways. Tat's wife Robin Tatman is the leader of our local Air Explorer Post in addition to flying for Delta Airlines.

April 1<sup>st</sup> Phil Cabaud and his son John Cabaud, Jr. formed Air Sonoma Aviation to offer flight instruction, flight introductions, rides and rental aircraft. They have been quite successful in teaching young and old the art of flight. Seventeen year old Colin Trainer was John's last student to earn his Private Pilot license on December 23, 2014. Congratulations are due to both of them.

The spring rains never showed up so SkyPark experienced considerable flying in spite of rising fuel prices. Our EAA Chapter 1268 hosted EAA VP Captain Jeff Skilles and several other guest speakers with very good messages. Our young airline alumni (relatively speaking) were called back to work during the spring and a couple of them started new airline careers. The Presten boy's solo experience continued with Ben's solo on his sixteenth birthday, February 18<sup>th</sup>. On June 5, the SkyPark pilots and friends hosted our almost annual "Sonoma SkyPark Family Fun Day". It continues to attract a crowd with airplanes and automobiles on display, raffle prizes, silent auction, parachute bingo and hay wagon rides for the young at heart. The weather was beautiful and our chefs served up close to 500 hamburgers and hot dogs with all the fixings.
